On 1263 a German Priest visiting Italy had doubts about the Real Presence of Jesus In the Eucharist. When celebrating Mass, having said the words of Consecration Blood started to seep from the Host on the corporal. This event was reported to the Pope who was visiting the nearby town of Oviato. The Host and Blood stained corporal were brought to Oviato and placed in the Cathedral there where they remain to the present day. The feast of Corpus Christi was

instituted and was celebrated for the first time in Oviato in 1264.

The Pope asked the Great Dominican Saint, Thoma Aquinas to compose a Mass and Office for the Holy Eucharist. We have these beautiful Hymus as a resut. - Pange Lingua, Tantum Ergo, Panis Angelicus, and Salutaris Hostia.
